- a. Find something you are passionate about.

- b. Enjoying every day what you are doing is critical for excelling which does not mean you won't have ups and downs.

### 2. Be real

- a. Critical is to have integrity and be transparent in your actions...those characteristics are critical for others to follow (and not for a quick fix but for years).

- c. Entrepreneurship is a team sport. To build a team, which is required in order to be successful in network marketing, you need to build relationships with people.
- d. Mother Teresa's wise words: "I can do things you cannot, you can do things I cannot; together we can do great things."

### 3. Work, work, work

- a. This sounds like it applies to every "job" as well, but NO. This entrepreneurship has a "work curve"...work, work, work, work, work, work, work, money. Work work, work, work, work, money, money. Work, work, work, work, money, money, money. Work, work, work, money, money money. Catch the idea?
- b. There really is no substitute for hard work! Lead by example. Set the example and others around you will respect you for your commitment.
- c. Focus your efforts on the activities that really make a difference and make you money. No distractions. Have a plan and stick to it. Steve Jobs said: "*I'm convinced that about half of what separates the successful entrepreneurs from the non-successful ones is pure perseverance*".

### 4. Think outside the box

- a. You must have vision: think bigger, think better, think smarter, think without limits. It's all about thinking outside the box, being creative, and disrupting the status quo – ***embrace change!***
- b. You need to go where there's some uncertainty and where you've not gone before, instead of being risk-averse and playing it safe – **entrepreneurs are risk-takers!** You therefore need to be prepared to look outside your comfort zone for solutions and opportunities.

### 5. Build your skills and network!

- a. Skills and competence are the key to success, so if you want to excel as an entrepreneur, it is imperative that you **learn all you can and keep learning.**
- b. As mentioned, it is vital to focus on the activities that make you money, and these are always having to do with your skills. So, investing time in training really is money in the bank – maybe not today, but certainly tomorrow. While it might seem difficult to find time to take a course, there are flexible online options which can fit around your busy schedule.
